- The organisers reserve the right to cancel or combine classes, alter advertised times or refuse entry. A waiting list will be held if oversubscribed.
- 2 It is a condition of entry that:
 - any person when mounted must wear a riding hat to a minimum of PAS 015:1998, PAS 015:2011 or VG01, Snell E2001or 2016 with official snell label and number or ASTM-F1163 2004a with SEI mark and correctly fastened at all times; Only a jockey skull with NO peak, and NO peak extensions are allowed.
 - b Body protectors must be worn, Level 3 BETA 2009 or 2018
 - c. HAT CAMERAS ARE NOT PERMITTED.
- 3. Entries will close at 1800hrs on Friday 17 May 2019. Entries can be made through EQUO EVENTS or entries accompanied by the appropriate entry fee with cheques payable to "Strathearn Eventing Ltd". Late entries maybe accepted at an additional £5 per entry. HC entries also accepted if numbers permit. No telephone entries will be accepted.
 - **No refund of entry money will be made after the closing date**. In the event of the hunter trial being cancelled for any reason, money will be refunded less 15% to cover admin fees.
- 4 Competitors requesting a preferred start time within their class should advise the Secretary on their entry form through the Equo entry or via post entry.
- Approximate times of starting will be available by telephoning 01738 840263 between 1700hrs and 1900hrs on Friday 24 May 2019 or on equoevents.
- 6 The course will be open for course walking from 1400hrs on Saturday 25 May 2019
- Any complaint must be made in writing accompanied by a £25 deposit to the Secretary. The deposit will be refunded if the complaint is upheld or at the discretion of the Chief Steward whose decision is final.
- 8 All horses and ponies must be 5 years old or over.
 - <u>Due to some riders in previous years not adhering to jump judges</u>, we have had to make the <u>decision to not allow eliminated riders to continue</u>. If in any doubt please come and school over the course at least 14 days beforehand although portables will be moved.
- In the interest of safety to riders and horses we **will** ask for those eliminated on the course to leave the course at a walk EXCEPT CLASS 6 that may continue only at discretion of jump judge and controller. If the rider has had two dismounts or is holding up the course or deemed unsafe you will be asked to leave the course.
- Please ensure that all litter and general debris is disposed of responsibly. Please do not muck out your horsebox in the horsebox park, IT'S A HAYFIELD.
- All classes will be run under BE Rules, however if a rider has one dismount and is deemed fit to remount by the medical team/jumpjudge/steward they maybe permitted. When a combination have three refusals at one jump, or 5 accumulative refusals on course riders will be asked to leave the course for safety reasons.

Classes 1-6 will be judged to an optimum time. No optimum time classes 7&8,.
